EXTRA INFORMATION & OVERVIEW OF ITINERARY

Munich (1 night), Hohenschwangau (2nights), Germany

For those spending pre-tour time in Munich there are lots of options, including the huge and impressive Nymphenburg Palace, BMW World & Museum at their home factory, the nearby 1972 Olympic Stadium, Marienplatz with its famous glockenspiel and the historic Hofbräuhaus beer hall.

We begin our tour in beautiful Bavaria. Prepare yourself for the 'Romantic Road' that will lead us amongst fairytale palaces nestled into the spectacular landscape, idyllic villages of half-timbered medieval houses and experience the culture, art, cuisine and history of this stunningly beautiful region. In these first days we explore Neuschwanstein Castle with its Wagner based theme and famous tapestries - to the world renowned village of Oberammergau and the World Heritage listed church of Wies to name just a few of the superb hand-picked sights and experiences.

Oberammergau Passion Play Information: Please note: we have not included the Passion Play in our tour as it may not be to everyone's tastes and endurance (2 sessions of 2½ hours each and all in German). For anyone who is interested in attending we and Kay may be able to make arrangements, but please give us as much notice as possible.

Salzburg, Austria (3 nights)

The musical city of Mozart's birth. Medieval and baroque buildings adorn the pedestrian Altstadt (Old City). An excursion to the famous Hohensalzburg (Salzburg Fortress), accessed via a fun funicular ride, provides a great view overlooking the old town below. There's a visit to the quirky and entertaining water gardens at Schloss Hellbrunn. Don't get wet! We also return to Germany for a visit to Berchtesgaden, then Obersalzberg - best known as the site of Adolf Hitler's former mountain residence, the Berghof, and of the mountaintop Kehlsteinhaus, popularly known as the 'Eagle's Nest.' We can visit the Documentation Obersalzberg Museum & Hotel Zum Turken (to view original bunkers), plus take a bus and elevator up to the 'Eagle's Nest'.

Hallstatt, Austria (3 nights)

Then it is on to one of the world's most beautiful lakeside villages. A UNESCO World Heritage Site - it is easy to see why she has a history of over 7000 years of habitation! Imagine wandering these quaint cobbled streets, exploring this superb lake by boat, walking the spectacular skywalk with breathtaking views, visiting the famous salt mines older than 3000 years, and wandering the numerous walking tracks. Our three nights here will delight all of the senses.

For those who would love to join Richard for his photography Workshop - what better place to begin using your new skills than here - surrounded by such stunning scenery.

For those who would like to try your hand at painting - Susan would love help you to capture the colour and magic of some of the destinations that take your breath away! Imagine capturing the feeling of 'being there' amongst the tranquil beauty of this exceptionally paintable village and lake. A magical memento of your tour! Vienna, Austria (4 nights)
